MINISTER OF RESEARCH, TECHNOLOGY AND HIGHER
EDUCATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

Considering : that in order to implement Article 52 paragraph (3) and Article 54 paragraph (8) of Law Number 12 of 2012 concerning Higher Education, it is necessary to stipulate the Regulation of the Minister of Research, Technology and Higher Education concerning Quality Assurance System for Higher Education;

Considering: 1. Law Number 12 of 2012 concerning Higher Education (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2012 Number 158, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5336);

2. Government Regulation Number 4 of 2014 concerning the Implementation of Higher Education and Management of Higher Education (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2014 Number 16, Supplement to State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5500);

3. Presidential Regulation No. 13/2015 on the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia 2015 No. 14);
4. Presidential Decree No. 121/P of 2014 on the Formation of Ministries and Appointment of Working Cabinet Ministers for the 2014-2019 Period;
5. Regulation of the Minister of Research, Technology and Higher Education Number 15 of 2015 on the Organization and Work Procedures of the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia 2015 Number 889);
6. Regulation of the Minister of Research, Technology and Higher Education Number 44 of 2015 concerning National Higher Education Standards (Berita Negara Republik Indonesia Tahun 2015 Number 1952);

DECIDE:

Establish: A REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF RESEARCH, TECHNOLOGY AND HIGHER EDUCATION ON HIGHER EDUCATION QUALITY ASSURANCE SYSTEM.

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

In this Ministerial Regulation, what is meant by:

1. The quality of higher education is the level of conformity between the implementation of higher education and Higher Education Standards consisting of National Higher Education Standards and Higher Education Standards Determined by Higher Education.
2. Higher Education Quality Assurance System, hereinafter abbreviated as SPM Dikti, is a systemic activity to improve the quality of higher education in a planned and sustainable manner.

3. Internal Quality Assurance System, hereinafter abbreviated as SPMI, is a systemic activity of higher education quality assurance by each university autonomously to control and improve the implementation of higher education in a planned and sustainable manner.
4. External Quality Assurance System, hereinafter abbreviated as SPME, is an assessment activity through accreditation to determine the feasibility and level of quality achievement of study programs and universities.
5. The Higher Education Database, hereinafter abbreviated as PDDikti, is a collection of data on the implementation of higher education throughout universities that are integrated nationally.
6. The National Higher Education Standards are a set of standards covering the National Education Standards plus the National Research Standards and the National Community Service Standards.
7. Higher Education Standards Set by Higher Education are a number of standards in higher education that go beyond the National Higher Education Standards.
8. Higher Education is an educational unit that organizes higher education.
9. The National Accreditation Board for Higher Education, hereinafter abbreviated as BAN-PT, is a body established by the Government to independently conduct and develop higher education accreditation.
10. Study program self-accreditation institution, hereinafter abbreviated as LAM, is an institution established by the Government or the community to conduct and develop study program accreditation independently.
11. Ministry is the government apparatus in charge of government affairs in the field of higher education.
12. Minister is the minister who organizes government affairs in the field of higher education.

13. Directorate General is the Directorate General of Learning and Student Affairs of the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education.

Article 2

- (1) SPM Dikti aims to ensure the fulfillment of Higher Education Standards systemically and continuously, so that a culture of quality grows and develops.
- (2) SPM Dikti serves to control the implementation of higher education by universities to realize quality higher education.

CHAPTER II

HIGHER EDUCATION QUALITY ASSURANCE SYSTEM MECHANISM

Article 3

- (1) SPM Higher Education consists of:
 - a. SPMI; and
 - b. SPME
- (2) SPMI as referred to in paragraph (1) letter a is planned, implemented, evaluated, controlled, and developed by universities.
- (3) SPME as referred to in paragraph (1) letter b is planned, evaluated, implemented, controlled, and developed by BAN-PT and / or LAM through accreditation in accordance with their respective authorities.
- (4) The output of SPMI implementation by higher education institutions as referred to in paragraph (2) is used by BAN-PT or LAM for determining the accredited status and ranking of higher education institutions or study programs.

Article 4

- (1) Planning, implementation, evaluation, control, and development of SPMI and SPME are based on Higher Education Standards.
- (2) Higher Education Standards as referred to in paragraph (1) consist of:
 - a. National Higher Education Standards; and

- b. Higher Education Standards Set by Higher Education Institutions.
- (3) The National Higher Education Standards are compiled and developed by the National Higher Education Standards Agency and stipulated in Ministerial Regulations.
- (4) Higher Education Standards Set by Higher Education Institutions are compiled and developed by higher education institutions and stipulated in regulations of higher education leaders for state universities, or regulations of organizing legal entities for private universities, after being approved by the senate at the higher education level.

Article 5

- (1) SPMI has a cycle of activities consisting of:
 - a. establishment of Higher Education Standards;
 - b. implementation of the Higher Education Standards;
 - c. evaluation of the implementation of Higher Education Standards
 - d. controlling the implementation of Higher Education Standards; and
 - e. improvement of Higher Education Standards.
- (2) Evaluation as referred to in paragraph (1) letter c is carried out through an internal quality audit.
- (3) SPMI implemented at all field of higher education activities, namely:
 - a. Academic, including education, research, and community service; and
 - b. non-academic, among others other source resources human resources, finance, facilities and infrastructure.
- (4) Activities as referred to in paragraph (3) are used to achieve Higher Education Standards.
- (5) SPMI as a system is evaluated and developed continuously by the universities concerned.
- (6) SPMI is stipulated in the regulation of higher education leaders for PTN or the regulation of the organizing legal entity for PTS, after being approved by the senate or academic senate of the higher education institution.

Article 6

- (1) SPME conducted through accreditation has a cycle of activities consisting of:
 - a. Data and Information Evaluation stage;
 - b. the stage of Determination of Accreditation Status and Accreditation Rating; and
 - c. Monitoring and Evaluation stage of Accreditation Status and Accredited Rating.
- (2) SPME is developed continuously by BAN-PT and/or LAM in accordance with their respective authorities.
- (3) Further provisions regarding the activity cycle as referred to in paragraph (1) shall be regulated in a Ministerial regulation.

Article 7

Data, implementation information, and outcomes of SPMI and SPME are reported and stored by universities in PDDikti.

CHAPTER III

DIVISION OF TASKS AND AUTHORITY

Article 8

- (1) The Directorate General has the duty and authority to formulate, coordinate, and implement Higher Education SPM policies.
- (2) The National Higher Education Standards Agency has the task and authority to compile and develop National Higher Education Standards.
- (3) The Directorate of Quality Assurance has the task and authority in the preparation of policy formulation, facilitation, implementation, coordination, supervision, monitoring control, evaluation and reporting in the field of SPMI.
- (4) Universities have duties and authorities:
 - a. plan, implement, evaluate, control, and develop SPMI;

- b. compile SPMI documents consisting of:
 - 1. SPMI policy document;
 - 2. SPMI manual document;
 - 3. standard documents in SPMI; and
 - 4. form documents used in SPMI;
 - c. establish a quality assurance unit or integrate SPMI into higher education management; and
 - d. managing PD Dikti at the tertiary level.
- (5) The National Accreditation Board for Higher Education (BAN PT) and / or Self-Accreditation Institution (LAM) has the duty and authority to conduct SPME through accreditation of Higher Education and / or study programs.

CHAPTER IV TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

Article 9

- (1) Before the National Higher Education Standards Agency as referred to in Article 8 paragraph (2) is formed, the duties and authorities of the National Higher Education Standards Agency are carried out by the National Education Standards Agency.
- (2) In carrying out its duties, the National Higher Education Standards Agency coordinates with the National Education Standards Agency.
- (3) Further provisions regarding the establishment of the National Higher Education Standards Agency are regulated by Ministerial Regulation.

CHAPTER V CLOSING PROVISIONS

Article 10

When this Ministerial Regulation comes into force, Minister of Education and Culture Regulation Number 50 of 2014 concerning Higher Education Quality Assurance System is revoked and declared invalid.

Article 11

This Ministerial Regulation shall come into force on the date of promulgation.

In order that every person may know it, this Ministerial Regulation shall be promulgated by placing it in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
